Guidelines for Full-time/Part-time Status change

Note that you must apply to the department in order to change your student status to **part-time** or **full-time**. The application **deadline** for changing student status is **Wednesday**, **5 November**, **2025**. Students are not allowed to apply to change **part-time/full-time** status after this date. You may submit an application for status change at the BME department office.

Guidelines To Undertake Non-Departmental Courses

In total, an **M.Sc. student** may register for up to 2 non-departmental courses (out of total 6 courses), while an **M.Engg. student** may register for up to 4 non-departmental courses (out of total 10 courses). To register for non-departmental courses, follow the steps below:

- 1. Obtain consent from your academic advisor/supervisor.
- 2. Prepare two application letters:
 - One addressed to the Head, BME seeking permission to register the non-departmental course.
 - Another addressed to the Head of the respective department offering the course.
- 3. Submit both letters to the BME Department Office.
